Kristian Kristansen is professor of archaeology at the University of Gothenburg, Sweden, and he is one of the World's foremost archaeologists. He has written extensively about the European Bronze Age, the Neolithic, archaeological theory, the history of archaeology and cultural heritage, and played a central role in the ongoing Third Science Revolution in archaeology. Kristiansen has led numerous international and interdisciplinary projects, served as director of the Danish Archeological Heritage Administration, was a driving force during the creation of the European Association of Archaeologists and was founding editor of the European Journal of Archaeology.
